### **REALM AND YOU**

You may be asking, "What is Realm and why I need to know about it?" Those are great questions and ones I hope will be beneficial to you. Realm is the church database software we use to keep up with all the church membership, track attendance in Sunday school, and keep financial records of giving for end of year tax purposes. So, the software is very useful for those in the church office on a daily basis. However, it can be very useful for all the church membership once everyone knows how to utilize it properly.

So, over the next few weeks and probably months, we are going to roll out Realm to the church. We are going to start with our lay leadership: deacons, Sunday school leaders, committee members, and then move out to the entire church. Ultimately, once everyone is on board, everyone in the church will be able to access an online directory of fellow church members, have communication options with other fellow committee members, and view their own personal giving record (even print a giving statement at the end of the year for tax purposes). All this information is currently in our database, but only accessible to staff who have login privileges. It is important to note that each login account is limited to what that person needs to be able to access. In other words, Fred cannot see what anyone in the church gives except what Fred gives.
