## The Third Sunday of Advent...Celebrating Peace and Joy

The following words come from Dietrich Bonhoeffer, a German pastor, in his "Letters from Prison" on November 21, 1943. He was arrested by the Nazis and sent to Flossenburg Concentration Camp. He was hanged at the age of 39 on April 9, 1945, only days before the Allied Forces liberated the camp. He wrote: "Life in a prison cell may well be compared to Advent; one waits, hopes, and does this, that, or the other- things that are of no real consequence – the door is shut, and can be opened only from the outside." How do you need to be liberated from your prison of anger, grudges, blindness, harsh words, or addictions to know His peace and joy? How can Jesus open your cell door today?
