Hey everyone, we want to let you know about a great opportunity to connect with Christ and your church family on Wednesday nights in the spring. We are going to begin having men's and women's small groups which meet together weekly to study scripture and build Christian community with one another.

One of the greatest strengths of First Baptist is being intergenerational. It's a natural way to accomplish the great commission by making disciples of one another with one another. These men's and women's small groups will provide an intentional way for you to build intergenerational relationships in our church. Young will learn from old and old will learn from young.

Each group will be capped at 10 people, which allows for greater discussion and closer community to be built. Registration will begin in January, and you will have an opportunity to register online to select the group you'd like to be a part of.

For comfortability and familiarity, you can register with some people you know. In addition, we also encourage you to branch out to connect with more people in our church as we strengthen our church by strengthening our relationships with one another. For these small groups, we will study the same story in Scripture 2 weeks in a row. This way of studying allows you to have initial thoughts and reflections of the passage the first week. It also lets the story ruminate in your mind through the week and then come back with other thoughts, questions, feelings, and applications. Prolonged study of a singular passage helps recollect Biblical truths when we encounter both joy and pain in our lives.

- 2. What did you struggle with in the story?
- 3. What did the story teach you about God?
- 4. What did the story teach you about people?

- 6. Who else do you know who needs to hear this story?

The boys have moved into their new space and the girls remain where they are until additional funds are secured. Gardens are taking shape and the whole crew is pitching in to help them flourish. The hope is that these gardens will produce food to supplement what they buy and also produce enough to sell and offset the cost.

The foster home has been receiving much attention, but there are numerous ministries J & B are involved in that you help support. The name of the overall ministry is Samaria Ministry. It includes church planting, discipleship, ministry training, preaching, and community engagement focused on the people group from which they originated.
